## Comptroller's Branch Offices to Return to Appointment-Only Visits

***Change effective October 4; Virtual appointments still available***

**ANNAPOLIS, Md. (October 1, 2021)** — Comptroller Peter Franchot today announced that all 12 agency branch offices will return to appointment-only visits, beginning Monday, October 4. The decision to temporarily suspend walk-in services will help keep the public and employees safe from the continued threat of COVID-19.
