On National Night Out, Comptroller Lierman to Stop in New Carrollton and Baltimore City to Support Law Enforcement Community

Comptroller staff to represent agency in Baltimore County, Annapolis, Bel Air, Columbia, Frederick, Salisbury, Takoma Park, and Waldorf

WHO: Comptroller Brooke Lierman

WHAT: Comptroller Brooke Lierman and her staff will join thousands of Marylanders in recognizing law enforcement officers and their efforts to make our communities safe places to live and work during National Night Out events being held throughout the state on August 1.

Comptroller Lierman will meet and speak with law enforcement officers and residents at two community-police awareness events in New Carrollton and Baltimore City. The Comptroller, who hails from Baltimore, will speak at the Baltimore City event. Staff members will fan out in other locations throughout the state to join the Comptroller in showing support for the law enforcement community.

National Night Out began in Philadelphia 39 years ago as a way to recognize the community work law enforcement officers do each day, including drug prevention, neighborhood watches, child safety seat inspections and other anti-crime programs. It now is an annual event to promote police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make communities safer and more caring places to live.
