Comptroller Franchot to Present Schaefer Awards on Eastern Shore

**His Hope Ministries in Caroline County and Paul Tue III
in Kent County will be honored**

WHO: Comptroller Peter Franchot

WHAT: Comptroller Franchot on Thursday afternoon will present the 2021 William Donald Schaefer Helping People Award to recipients in Caroline and Kent counties. He first will recognize His Hope Ministries in Denton, which helps homeless people and those who need housing stabilization.

The Comptroller then will head to Chestertown, where he will recognize Paul Tue III for his lengthy community service and activism to improve the lives of young African-Americans. He currently is co-founder and director of Minary's Dream Alliance.

The Helping People Award was created to honor the legacy of public service exemplified by former Governor, Comptroller and Baltimore City Mayor William Donald Schaefer. One winner is selected annually from each of Maryland's 24 jurisdictions. This is the 10th year that Comptroller Franchot has presented Schaefer awards to worthy recipients throughout Maryland.
