## Personal Income Tax Filing Extension Ends October 15

*Comptroller's Office reminds Marylanders of services to assist taxpayers*

**ANNAPOLIS, Md. (October 9, 2024)** — Marylanders who filed for an extension on their 2023 personal income tax returns must file their returns by October 15, 2024.

“The upcoming filing deadline is available so that taxpayers who needed more time to file their tax returns can do so without unnecessary penalty,” **Comptroller Brooke Lierman** said. “Our agency is available to Marylanders who need assistance in meeting the deadlines, and we encourage people to take advantage of our services as needed.”

Free in-person state preparation is available at the [11 branch offices](#) throughout the state. Maryland taxpayers can receive help in-person, or during a virtual appointment, as long as they have completed a federal return.

Taxpayers who filed for an extension on a federal return and did not owe state taxes received a six-month extension for a state return. Extension requests are not granted beyond the six-month period, unless someone is currently located outside of the United States. In this case, tax filers can request an extension of up to one year.
